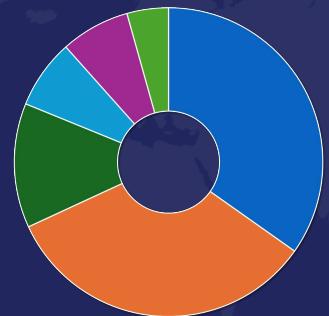

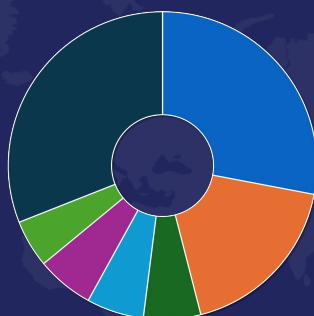


Mentee Impact

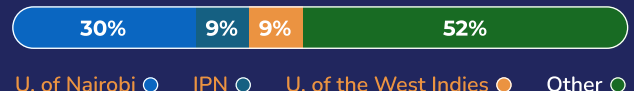

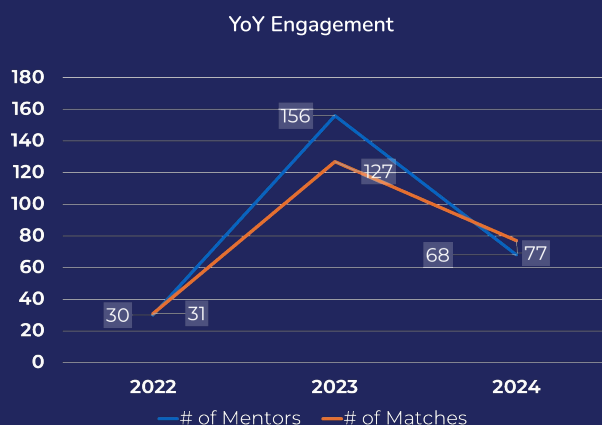
The LinkedIn-GMI Community
